

Preparing for your pets blood glucose curve at Bridgeport Veterinary Hospital

Thank you for taking the time to let us assist you with your pet's care. The blood glucose curve will help your veterinary team see a more accurate representation of your pet's blood glucose levels through out the day.

After scheduling a time/day you can drop off your pet to Bridgeport Veterinary Hospital with one of our staff members there will still be a few things to prepare for your visit.

1- Upon arrival a staff member will have you sign a consent for treatment form, and will ask you a few questions about your pet before dropping him/her off for the day.

2- We will take a blood glucose measurement **before** feeding your pet and record the value. Please bring your pet's normal meals **AND** Insulin with you so we may give after first reading. We will ask you to drop as early as business hours allow to keep your pet as close to home schedule as possible.

3- Please include any night time meals or medications.

4- We will administer insulin as directed please remember your pets insulin, syringes and dosage instructions.

5- Typically your pet will be with us til around 6-7pm. If you pet can go home sooner or business hours are altered a staff member will contact you. ***Please make sure someone is available for any questions or changes.***

6- A blood sample is taking through out the day, these values are recorded and giving to your regular veterinarian for interpretation. Please allow a few days for results to be evaluated and your regular veterinarian contacted.
